- ✓ Garbage and recyclables will be collected every Thursday. Place trash and recyclables at the curb by 6:30 a.m.
- ✓ Garbage may be placed in bags not exceeding 30 gallons or containers not exceeding 40 gallons in size.
- ✓ Recyclables may be placed in any container or in blue or clear bags not exceeding 30 gallons in size. Recyclable materials including paper, cardboard, glass, plastic, tin and aluminum may be mixed and placed in the same container.
- ✓ Wittenberg Disposal Services, LLC will collect large items as listed below on the **third Thursday** of each month. **Residents must contact Wittenberg Disposal in advance for the collection of large items.** Call the phone number listed above to schedule large item collections.
- ✓ Wittenberg Disposal Services, LLC will accept appliances, including refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners and other items containing refrigerants, water heaters, water conditioners, bulky household items, furniture, mattresses, toilets, computers and related office equipment, televisions, microwaves, lawn mowers, and bikes. Special collection rates are assessed for disposing of these items. The Town of Grant (your tax dollars) will pay the special collection fees using budgeted funds designated for waste disposal and recycling services. **This service is limited to Town of Grant residents only.**
- ✓ Wittenberg Disposal Services, LLC will not accept building demolition, construction debris, or carpeting. Contact the company for details on how to dispose of these items.
- ✓ Wittenberg Disposal Services, LLC will not accept tires, liquid waste, yard waste, asbestos in any form, contaminated soils or non-liquid industrial wastes, hazardous or infectious waste.
- ✓ Any questions or concerns related to garbage disposal and recycling may be directed to Wittenberg Disposal Services, LLC or the town clerk.

Additional Recycling Information

Residents of Shawano County may use the Shawano Landfill for disposing of items not collected by our hauler. Transportation and tipping fees are the responsibility of the individual. The Shawano Landfill will accept tires, demolition waste, and many other items. Used batteries and waste oil are accepted at the landfill free of charge. Contact the town clerk or Shawano County Landfill at (715) 524-2230 for additional information.

Shawano County Residents may use the Brown County Household Hazardous Waste Facility located at 2561 S. Broadway in the Village of Ashwaubenon to dispose of hazardous household items. Contact the clerk for more information about this free service.

Burning Permits

Permits are required for burn barrels and brush burning in the Town of Grant. Burning permits are available from Joanne Kostlevy at Plain Sense Printing, W13747 County Road M, Caroline, Wisconsin. For additional information contact Joanne at 715/754-2445.

Only the following items can be burned in barrels: **leaves, plant clippings, paper, cardboard, and clean untreated wood**. However, clean paper and cardboard should be recycled rather than burned. Prohibited materials include household garbage, wet food scraps, plastics, foam, synthetic materials, treated/painted wood, asphalt, rubber and other man-made materials. Burning prohibited materials releases harmful chemicals, such as dioxins, mercury, and lead into the air, soil and water of our beautiful state. Please use burn barrels sparingly and do not burn prohibited materials. Thank you.
