The Town of Grant Board does hereby ordain to create a new Town Ordinance as follows:

**ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH ALL-TERRAIN AND UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE
ROUTES IN THE TOWN OF GRANT
No: 2017-01**

SECTION I - INTENT

The Town of Grant, Shawano County adopts the following All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV) and Utility Terrain Vehicle (UTV) ordinance for the operation of ATVs and UTVs upon all designated roadways of the township.

SECTION II - STATUTORY AUTHORITY

The Town Board of the Town of Grant, Shawano County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority to adopt this (ATV) and (UTV) Ordinance under s. 23.33 (8) (b) and 11, Wis. Stats.

SECTION III - OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES AND UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLES

Pursuant to s. 23.33 (4) (d) 4., Wis. Stats., except as otherwise provided in s. 23.33 (4), Wis. Stats., no person may operate an ATV or UTV on the roadway portion of any highway in the town except on roadways that are designated as ATV and UTV routes by this ordinance. Operation of ATVs and UTVs on a roadway in the town that is an ATV and UTV route is authorized only for the extreme right side of the roadway except that left turns may be made from any part of the roadway that is safe given prevailing conditions.

SECTION V - DESIGNATION OF ATV AND UTV ROUTES

A. The following routes are designated ATV and UTV routes in the town:

SECTION VI - CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO ATV AND UTV ROUTES

Pursuant to s. 23.33 (8) (d), Wis. Stats., the following restrictions are placed on the use of the town ATV and UTV routes designated by this resolution:

A. Routes shall be marked with uniform ATV and UTV route signs in accordance with s. NR 64.12 (7), Wisconsin Administrative Code.

B. Operation shall be subject to all provisions of s. 23.33 Wis. Stats., which is adopted as a part of this ordinance by reference, pursuant to s. 23.33 (11) Wis. Stats.

C. All ATV/UTV operators shall observe posted roadway speed limits.

D. All ATV/UTV operators shall ride single file.

E. All ATV/UTV operators shall slow the vehicle to 10 miles per hour or less when operating within 150 feet of a dwelling.

F. All ATV/UTV operators must stay on the paved portion of roads. No riding on the shoulder of roads.

G. All ATV/UTV operators must be 16 years of age or older.

H. ATV/UTVs can only be operated from 5:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on designated town roads.

SECTION VI - ENFORCEMENT

The Town of Grant Board gives the authority to enforce this ordinance to the State of Wisconsin Highway Patrol, Shawano County Sheriff's Department, Town of Grant Chairperson, or his designee, and/or the Town Board Supervisors and their designee, and any other enforcement authority as allowed by Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION VII - PENALTIES

Wisconsin State All-Terrain and Utility Terrain Vehicle penalties as found under s. 23.33 (13) (a), Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference

SECTION VIII - LAWS

The Town of Grant accepts no liability for the operation of ATV/UTV's on any Town Road under the provision of this Ordinance.


SECTION X - SEVERABILITY


The provision of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town of Grant would have passed the other provision of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other person's circumstances shall not be deemed affected.


SECTION XI - EFFECTIVE DATE


This ordinance shall take effect upon passage, publication or posting and can be reviewed the Town Board at their discretion. A copy of the Ordinance and any revisions thereto, shall be sent by the Town Clerk to the Department of Natural Resources, The Shawano County Sheriff's Department and any other law enforcement agency serving in the Town of Grant's jurisdiction.

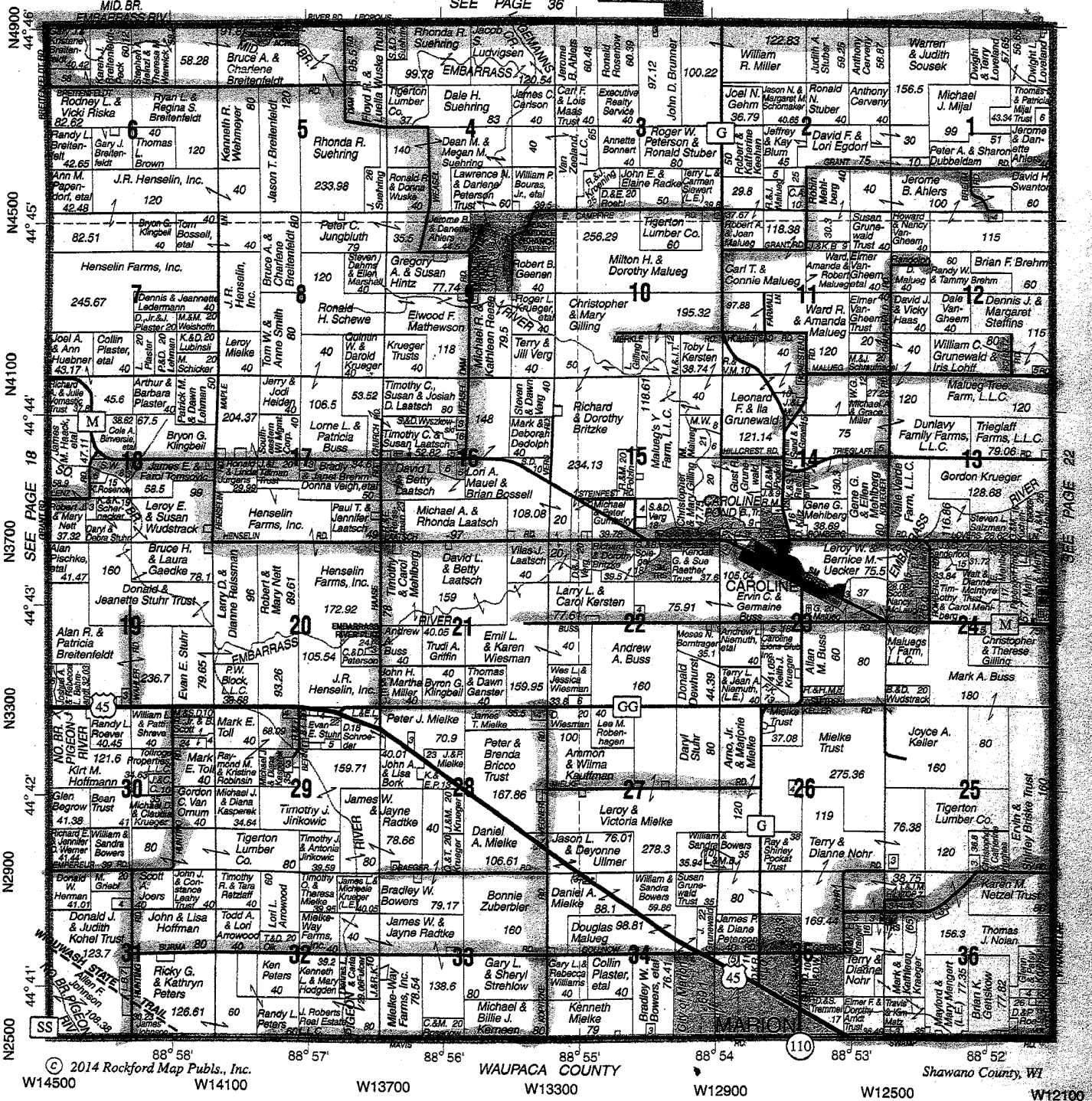
