

Ordinance 2018-01 Parking Restrictions

The Town Board of the Town of Grant, Shawano County, Wisconsin has the specific authority under Wisconsin Statute Section 349.13 to adopt this Ordinance.

This Ordinance adopted by a majority of the Town Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of the stopping, standing or parking of motorhomes/semi-trailers/large boats/tractor trailers on Village Streets and County Roads in the Town as follows:

A. The stopping, standing or parking of motorhomes/semi-trailers/large boats/tractor trailers for a period of days in excess of three (3) consecutive days in a 30-day period between the months of April and November on all Village Streets, including County Roads M and G in the Town of Grant is prohibited. No one shall park on the streets during the time frame that Caroline celebrates Colorama. Parking for longer than three days is at the discretion of the Grant Town Board. The Town roads affected by this Ordinance are specifically described as:

All Village Streets, County Road M, and County Road G

B. The Town Chairperson or his or her designee shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above described roads on or before the effective date of this Ordinance.

C. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$150.00 nor more than \$300.00 per Wisconsin Statute Section 349.13(1m) (a).

D. The Town of Grant gives the authority to enforce this Ordinance to the State of Wisconsin Highway Patrol, Shawano County Sheriff's Department, Town of Grant Chairperson or his or her designee and/or the Town Board of Supervisors and their designees and any other enforcement authority as allowed by Wisconsin Statute.

This Ordinance is effective on passage, publication or posting as required under Wisconsin Statute 60.08.
