

ORDINANCE TO APPOINT CLERK AND TREASURER

Ordinance No. 2020-01

The Town Board of the Town of Grant, Shawano County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That, pursuant to Wis. Stat. 60.30(1e) (a), the office of the Town Clerk **and** the office of Town Treasurer shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the Town Board.

The term of office for the appointed position(s) shall be set by the Town Board, but may not exceed 3 years per Sec. 60.30(1e) (c). The town board may re-appoint the officer(s) for additional terms. However, removal by the Town Board during a given term of office may only be for "cause" as defined under Sec. 17.001 and required by Sec. 60.30(1e) (f).

This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board be held on Tues. November 3, 2020. The referendum questions shall be:

"Shall the person holding the office of Town Clerk in the Town of Grant be appointed by the Town Board?"

And

"Shall the person holding the office of Town Treasurer in the Town of Grant be appointed by the Town Board?"

The salary of the appointed position(s) shall be set by the Town Board and may not be reduced during the term of office.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its Town Board passage, notice after passage per Sec. 60.80 and also referendum approval by the town electors as required by Sec. 60.30(1e) (b).
